Facts found:	<p>POR clear ahead and TUR clear astern on starboard tack when entering the zone at mark 2. At the mark TUR's bow hit POR's rudder and broke the fittings on the hull and on the rudder.</p> <p>POR without a rudder had to retire from the race and could not sail in race 10.</p> <p>TUR did a two turn penalty.</p>
Conclusion:	<p>TUR did not keep clear as a boat clear astern and did not give room at the mark.</p> <p>There was serious damage why the penalty taken will not exonerate the infringement.</p>
